

Costs/Fees related to UniversalEHR.com	Costs
Costs/Fees to Use	<i>Users can purchase the software license on a monthly or annual basis. Licenses are per user and differ based on whether the user is provider or non-provider. \$49.00/month for non-providers and \$99.00/month per provider. A provider is any user that has an active DEA or NPI number entered into their profile.</i>
Required 3rd Party Software	<i>The computer that is using UniversalEHR.com must have Adobe Reader to print or view any reports. To export reports, the computer must have Microsoft Office Excel.</i>
Support	<i>The monthly licensing fee supports end users and gives them access to product updates, database updates, version upgrades, and technical support.</i>
E-Prescription	<i>There is \$35.00/monthly fee per user for E-Prescription (NewCrop). It is not necessary to engage or contract with NewCrop, however user must agree to the terms and conditions.</i>
Setup and Installation	<i>There are no start-up, setup, or training fees. Travel fees will be incurred accordingly.</i>
Data Storage	<i>Providers must sign a contract in order to use the product with the understanding that storage of the first 4,000 patients are free, \$2.00/patient after the initial 4,000 will be assessed</i>
3rd party integrated apps	<i>UniversalEHR.com contains the ability to add 3rd party applications. These applications typically carry monthly fees for their use such as: EMRDirect.</i>
Data Interfaces	<i>Custom programming to interface to 3rd party application for sharing data can carry annual maintenance fees depending on complexity.</i>
Cost for Meaningful Use Certified Products	<i>There are no limitations or additional costs for the EHR products that are certified.</i>



Contracts and Limitations

All users must sign a contract for use of the UniversalEHR.com products. The term of the contracts can be for 6 months, 12 months or shorter/longer durations under certain circumstances.

All users must accept End User License Agreement (EULA); available to users prior to purchase.

UniversalEHR.com requires the usage of Adobe Reader for patient portal.

UniversalEHR.com is a web-based application and functions on Windows-based computer and tablets.

The UniversalEHR.com version 2.0.0, certification from ONC-ACB is intentionally meant for an ambulatory setting only.

Microsoft Office, including Word and Excel are required for printing certain documents and reports in UniversalEHR.com. Microsoft is not included in UniversalEHR.com. Software must be purchased separately at the end user's cost.
